

# Setting Up Your DataMan 8700

## Install the DataMan SetupTool

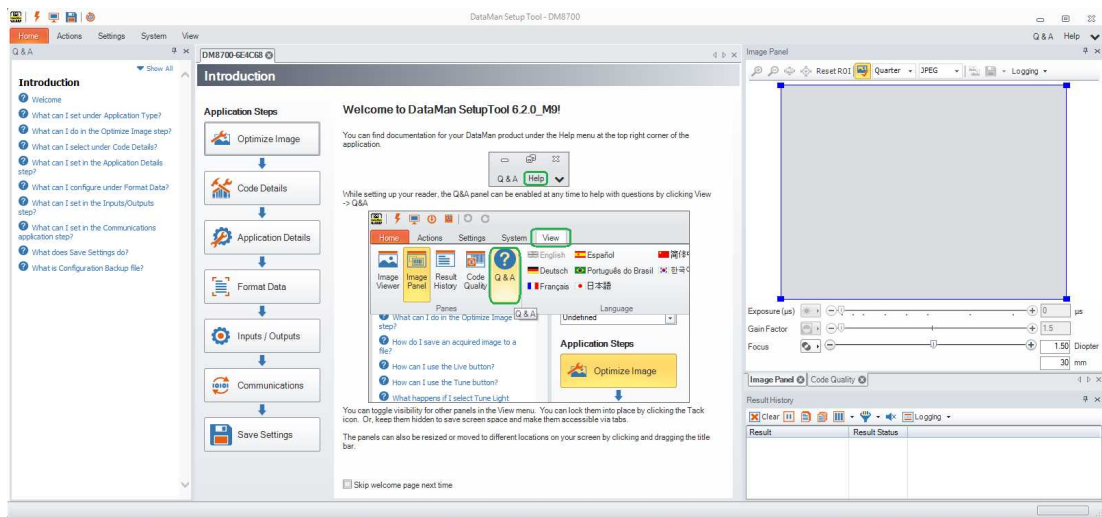
To configure a DataMan 8700 reader, the DataMan Setup Tool software must be installed on a networked PC. The DataMan Setup Tool is available from the DataMan support site: <http://www.cognex.com/support/dataman>.

1. After installing the software, connect the DataMan 8700 to your PC.
2. Launch the DataMan Setup Tool and click **Refresh**.
3. Select your DataMan 8700 Series reader from the list and click **Connect**.

## Setting Up the Reader

To connect to the reader or base station on your computer:

1. Install the DataMan Setup Tool on your computer.



2. Select the connection type: Ethernet, RS-232 Serial, or USB, and connect the cables respectively.

3. Turn on your device(s).

# Connection Options

## Connecting Corded DataMan 8700DX

1. Connect the serial slide-in to your DataMan 8700. See the list of serial slide-ins in [Miscellaneous Accessories on page 6](#).

**Note:** Disconnect the DataMan 8700 from power before inserting or removing the communication modules.

2. Insert the plug, slide the cable lock up to the reader and twist the cable lock in place. See available cables in chapter [Cables on page 8](#)

**Note:** USB and RS232 devices need external power.

## Troubleshooting an Ethernet Connection

If your reader does not appear in the DataMan Setup Tool's list of detected network devices, adjust your network settings.

1. Check your Ethernet connection and click **Refresh** in the DataMan Setup Tool.
2. Scan the **Enable DHCP** code (which you can find in the *DataMan Reader Configuration Codes* document available from the Windows **Start** menu or the Setup Tool **Help** menu). This allows the reader to acquire a suitable IP address from a DHCP server on your subnet.

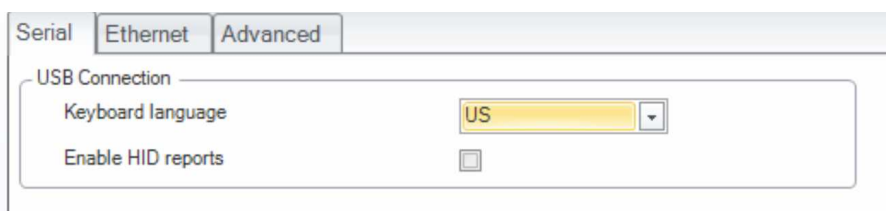
If the reader still does not appear, you can use the **Add Device** option in the DataMan Setup Tool.

If you know the IP address of the reader, use the **Add Network Device** option under **Repair & Support**. This method allows the DataMan 8700 reader to appear in the list of **Network devices** so that you can connect to it through the DataMan Setup Tool and your Ethernet connection.

## Using Your Device Through USB

You can connect your reader both with a coiled or a straight USB cable to use the device in USB 2.0 mode.

Change the **USB Connection** properties in the **Serial** tab of the **Communication Settings** pane in DataMan Setup Tool, or scan the appropriate code from the *DataMan Configuration Codes* document.



You can also switch the reader to USB mode with a pair of reader configuration codes in the *DataMan Configuration Codes* document. You can enable HID reports by ticking the checkbox in Setup Tool.



1. Open the target window and make sure it is the active window.
2. Start scanning codes with your corded reader.

## Changing Communication in DataMan 8700 Corded Reader

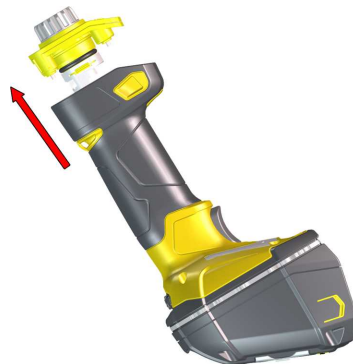
The communication modularity of the DataMan 8700 reader allows using USB, Ethernet and RS-232 slide-in communication type conversion kits. Follow the steps to change the communication conversion kit:

1. Remove the four screws located on the end cap assembly at the base of the reader using a Hex 2.0 mm screwdriver.

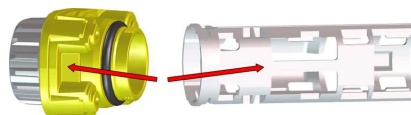
**Note:** Save the screws for later use.



2. Pull out the end cap assembly with the internal communication slide-in.



3. Separate the internal slide-in from the end cap assembly.



4. Line up the new communication slide-in with the rails on the internal sides of the reader.



5. Insert Internal communication slide-in.

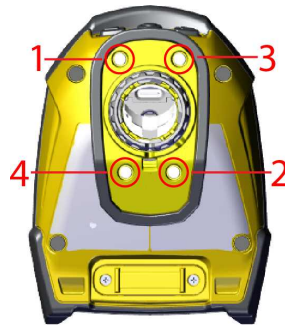


6. Replace the end cap assembly.



7. Insert the screws into the end cap assembly using a Hex 2.0 mm screwdriver.

**i Note:** Use 0.6 Nm (5.31 in-lb) torque on the screws and tighten in the sequence shown in the image.



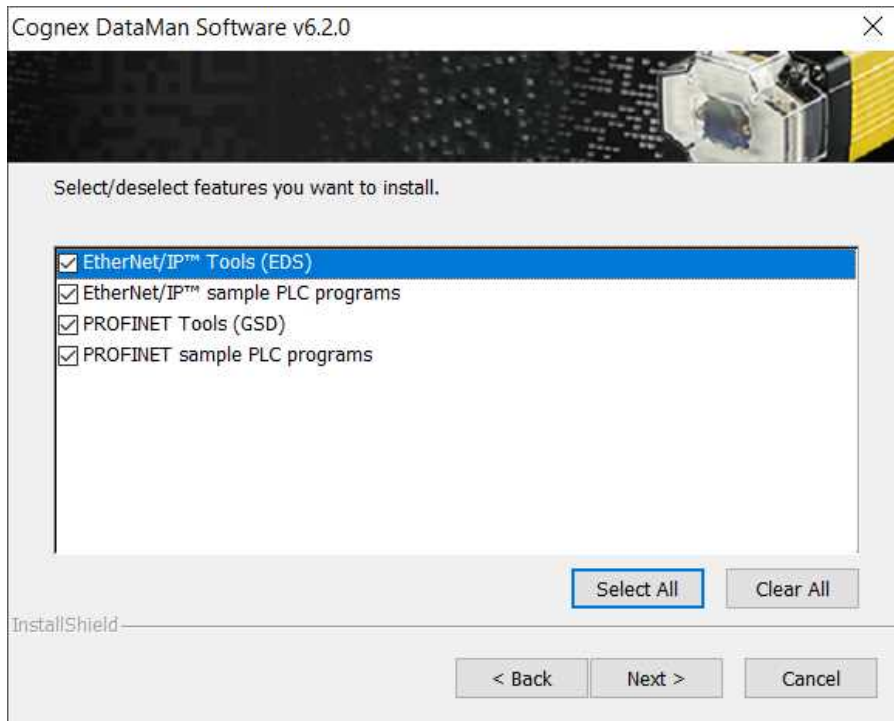
# Reading Codes with the DataMan 8700

## Industrial Protocols

The DataMan 8700 readers support the following industrial protocols:

- EtherNet/IP™
- PROFINET

Select the industrial protocol tools and sample programs when installing the DataMan Setup Tool.



There are three ways to enable or disable Industrial Protocols. Using either method, rebooting the reader is required for the changes to take effect.

- Enable the protocols using the **Industrial Protocols** pane of the DataMan Setup Tool under **Communication Settings**.
- Scan the appropriate **Reader Configuration codes** (see the **Reader Configuration Codes Manual** available through the Windows **Start** menu, the Setup Tool **Help** menu, or the [Cognex Documentation Portal](#)).
- Send the appropriate **DMCC** (see the **DataMan Control Commands Documentation** available through the Windows **Start** menu or the Setup Tool **Help** menu).

## Trigger Types

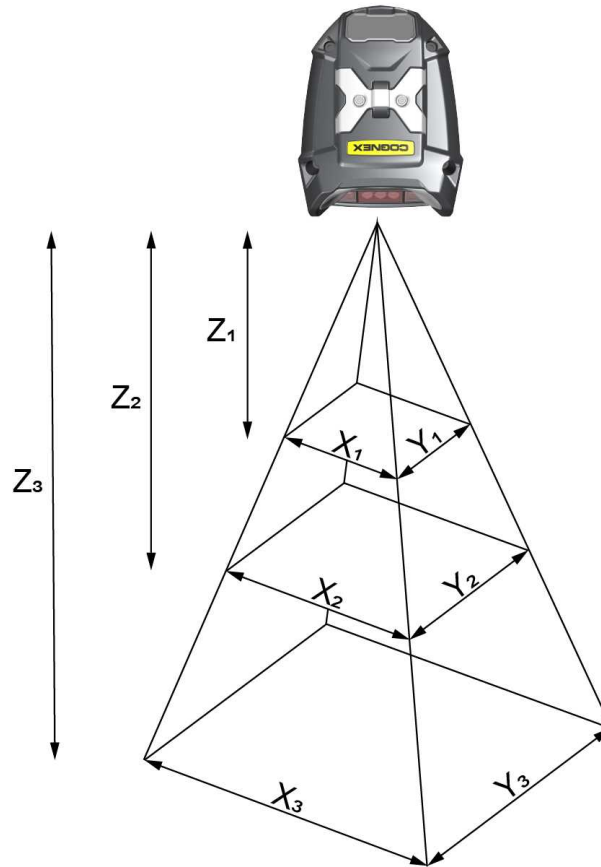
The DataMan 8700 trigger mode determines when the reader attempts to read a code. Use the DataMan Setup Tool or the appropriate reader configuration codes to change trigger types.

Supported trigger types:

- Manual (default): Pressing the trigger button on the reader starts image acquisition. The reader continues to acquire images until there is a detectable and decoded image or until the release of the trigger button.
- Presentation: When motion is detected in front of the reader, the reader turns on and scans for a symbol. When no motion is detected, the LED aimer and the lights turn off. The reader relies on an internal timing mechanism to acquire images.

## Field of View and Reading Distances

The following map shows the range of reading distances available for different code sizes and focus positions.

# Cleaning and Maintenance

## Cleaning the Reader Housing

To clean the outside of the reader housing, use a small amount of mild detergent cleaner or isopropyl alcohol on a cleaning cloth. Do not pour the cleaner on the reader housing.

## Cleaning the Reader Lens Cover

To remove dust from the lens cover, use a pressurized air duster. The air must be free of oil, moisture or other contaminants that could remain on the lens cover. To clean the plastic window of the lens cover, use a small amount of isopropyl alcohol on a cleaning cloth. Do not scratch the plastic window. Do not pour the alcohol on the plastic window.
